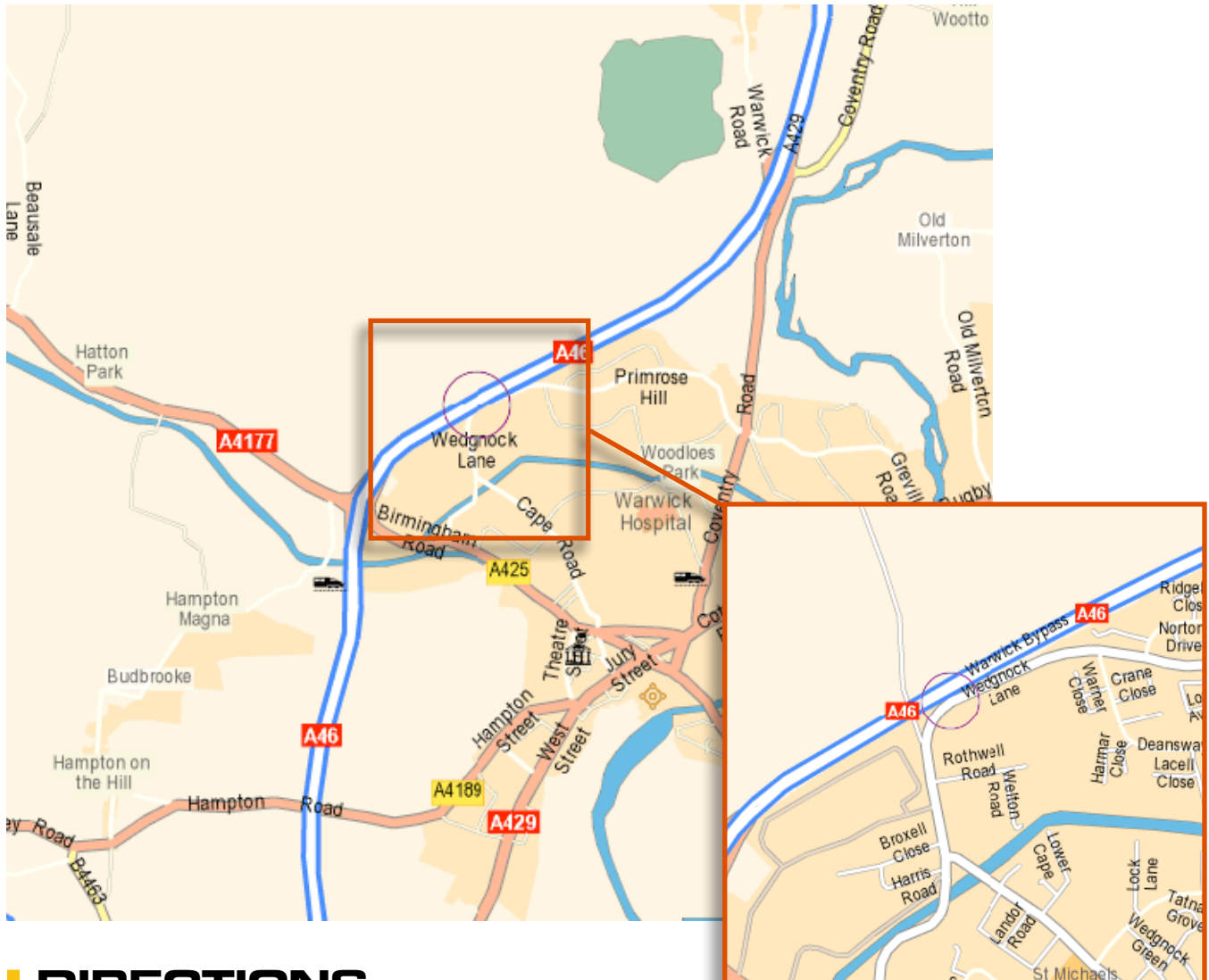

to Wedgnock House - Warwick

FROM M40 J15

Leave the M40 at junction 15 (signed Warwick, A429, Stratford, Coventry & A46). Join the A46 (Warwick bypass) following signs for Coventry. Leave the A46 (Warwick bypass) at the junction with the A4177/A425. Join the A425 (Birmingham Road) following signs for Warwick. At the roundabout turn left into Wedgnock Lane. The Professional Development Centre building is located on the right-hand side.

FROM A46/COVENTRY

Leave the A46 (Warwick bypass) at the junction with the A4177/A425. Join the A425 (Birmingham Road) following signs for Warwick. At the roundabout turn left into Wedgnock Lane. The Professional Development Centre building is located on the right-hand side.

BY TRAIN

Warwick receives services from Birmingham Snow Hill, Stratford, Leamington Spa, Banbury, Oxford, Reading and London Marylebone.

BY BUS

Goldline operates a regular G1 bus every 10 minutes from Leamington to Wedgnock House and Warwick Market Square and in reverse. A bus stop for the G1 bus is outside Wedgnock House.
